- Collect clothes and toys you no longer use and have a yard sale or take them to a consignment store (if you would like to drop-off items for consignment, see the back).

On Sunday, November 3rd you will return your jar when we march into the Worship Service and dump all the change into one big container. This will also show the adults that we are increasing our generosity and growing our faith. You may still give an offering after that date, but that is the only day we will be giving our change during the Worship Service.
